 - e. Main CMS Bulletin Board / Forum / Blog Tool
 - i. The Bulletin Board / Forum / Blog tool that is available within the Faculty Pages CMS is now available within the Main CMS.
 - ii. The tool operates like the tool that exists within the Faculty Pages CMS.
 - f. rSchoolToday Integration
 - i. Same setup as ScheduleStar
 - ii. Includes real-time integration to work
 - iii. To get started, you will need your Feed URL. Send a support ticket to us using the Support Center and be sure to include your Feed URL.
 - g. New Database Structure / 4Schools User Accounts Consolidation
 - i. In the next 12 months, we are planning on an overhaul of CMS4Schools that will improve performance and will make it much easier to use. That is, we will be building the next generation of this product. This will be done in a 2 step process.
 - 1. Back-end / database change (new foundation)
 - 2. Design / User interface changes
 - ii. Advantages
 - 1. Performance Improvements
 - 2. Single database of users for all 4Schools applications
 - 3. Single support center for all 4Schools applications
 - 4. Single LDAP account for all 4School applications
 - 5. Allow us to build the new and improved interface in the coming year.
 - 6. Easier for us to do a data restore for a single client if necessary.
 - 7. Able to increase our storage capacity for all our applications with scalable, add-on storage.
 - iii. Timeline for New Database migrations (Evening of April 30, 2010)

- h. New Extra Storage Space Server / Pricing (Begin on July 1, 2010)
 - i. Give clients the first 500 MB of storage space for free. This was previously 300 MB.
 - ii. Larger increments so that do not need to constantly bump up your space.
 - iii. Previously was \$50 for each 100 MB. (Equates to \$500 for each 1 GB)
 - iv. Now, it will be a graduated scale that will cap out at only \$100 for each 1 GB once you get above 7 GB.

- i. Currently developing a new product called Calendars4Schools (Available by the time school is out)
 - i. Used for public and private events.
 - ii. Fully integrated with CMS4Schools for public calendars
 - iii. Facility management tool integrated with signup sheets
 - 1. Registered users can request facilities on a regular basis with ease
 - 2. Able to reserve resources with a facility
 - iv. Some improvements over current calendars
 - 1. Ability to attach files to events
 - 2. Printable view for a publishable calendar
 - 3. Add a date picker for recurring events
 - 4. Calendar categories and subcategories
 - 5. Able to attach events to a school
 - v. Fees

 - b. Enhancements
 - i. User / Page Permissions Reports – Build in the functionality to allow admins to determine what users have permissions to any given page.
 - ii. CMS Files / Page Association Report - Right now, when viewing the Disk Usage Report, all files associated with a tool that permits uploading of files are stored within the "/cms_files" folder. This added feature will allow you to associate files with the page(s) where they exist.
 - iii. Forgot Password - Currently there isn't a forgot username or password feature when logging in. Create the same functionality as what is in the 4Schools products.
 - iv. New Scholarship Tool
 - v. Upcoming Events Color Coding - Ability to assign a color to event categories that is displayed next to each event in the Upcoming Events tool.



- vi. Page / Tool Tracking - Display on the admin side when and by who each page detail item was last updated.
- vii. File Uploads - Provide the ability to upload .zip files in all file uploads areas.
